

# Analyze Stage Reflection Questions

---

By reflecting on the **analyze** stage using the 5Rs—Representation, Relationships, Reflexivity, Responsibility, and Resources—you will focus on incorporating community voice in your data analysis and interpretation processes. These reflections will help you collaborate with community partners and plan for their involvement in this stage. Use the following reflection questions to guide your thinking through this stage.

## Representation

- Whose perspectives are included in the analysis and interpretation process? Whose voices may be missing?
- How does your analysis approach reflect the values, experiences, and context of the community?

## Relationships

- What steps are you taking to create an environment where all partners feel comfortable sharing honest feedback, even if it is critical or different from others' views?
- How are you ensuring open and consistent communication with partners throughout this stage?

## Reflexivity

- How are you identifying and addressing your own assumptions, preferences, or biases during analysis?
- In what ways have you adapted your approach or understanding based on input from community partners?

## Responsibility

- Do all partners understand their roles and how their input will shape the final interpretation of findings?
- What process will you use to navigate disagreements about how to interpret or represent the data?

## Resources

- Are partners receiving the tools, training, or compensation they need to contribute meaningfully to analysis and interpretation?
- How will you respond if new needs or challenges come up during this stage of the work?
