

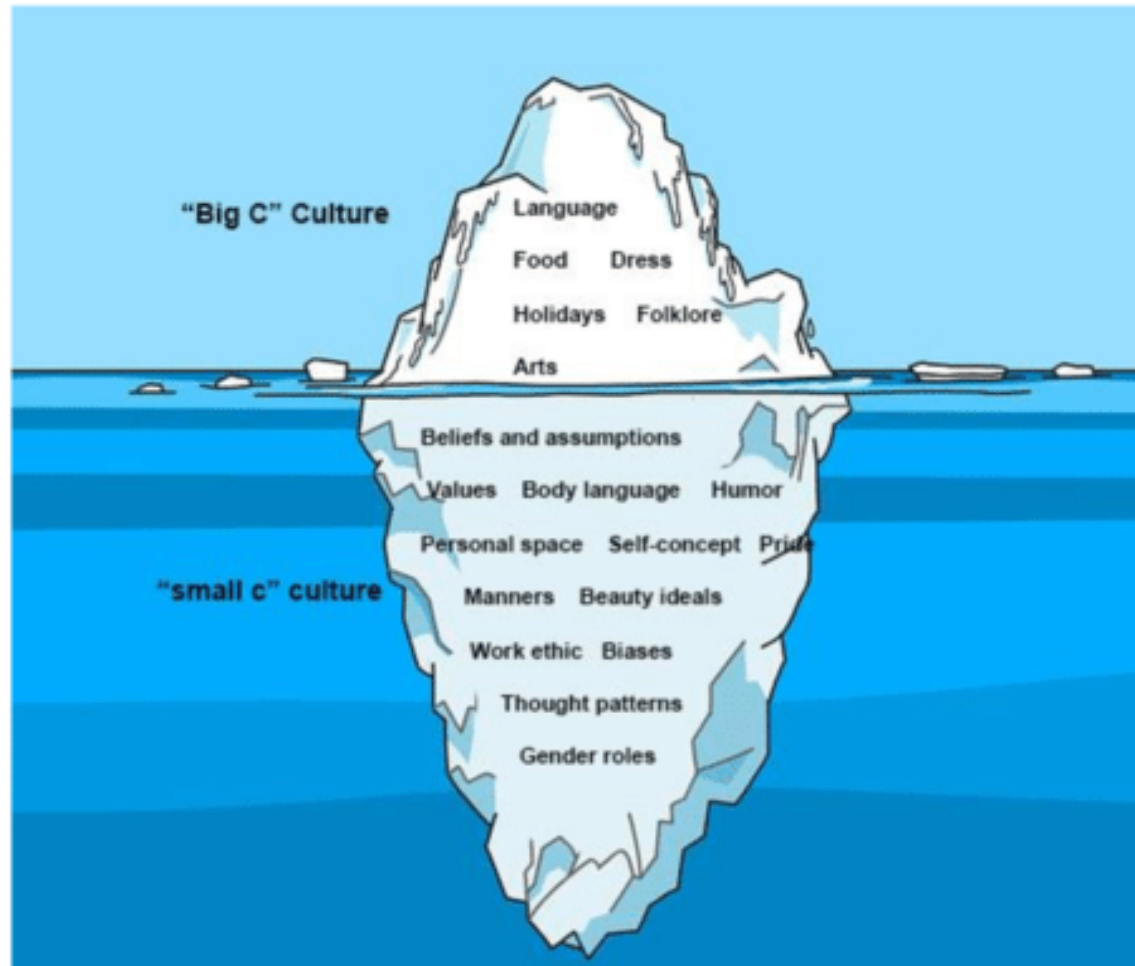

Cultural Competence in Research

- Cultural competence in research = the ability of researchers and research staff to provide high quality research that takes into account the diversity of a study population's values, beliefs, and behaviors when developing research ideas, conducting research, and exploring applicability of findings.

Cultural Competence in Research

- Historical contexts for study populations
- Build trust and understanding with participants
- Communicate effectively to explore customs, values, and beliefs
